MASTER'S DISSERTATION PRIZE

2017

The Council of the Royal Archaeological Institute invites nominations from UK universities and colleges for its biennial Master's dissertation prize.

In 2017, the RAI award will be for the best Master's dissertation on a subject concerned with the archaeology or architectural history of Britain, Ireland and adjacent areas of Europe. The winner will receive a prize of £500, one year's Ordinary membership and the opportunity for a paper based on the dissertation to be published in the *Archaeological Journal*. The chief criteria considered are (a) quality of work and (b) appropriateness to the interests of the RAI as reflected in the *Journal*. The award will be presented at a London meeting of the Royal Archaeological Institute on 14th March 2018.

University and college departments are invited to submit **no more than one dissertation** by the **10th December 2017**, although earlier submissions would be appreciated. In cases where an institution has more than one department teaching in the areas covered, each may make a separate entry but a single selected entry would be preferred.

Dissertations which have been submitted for publication in another journal will not be eligible for consideration. Only a dissertation already submitted for a Master's degree in 2016 and 2017 will be considered. The best dissertation from those years may be put forward.

An **electronic** copy of the dissertation should accompany the completed form.
